



Red Light - not interested: Rejoice in your obedience and pray for them.



Yellow - interested in learning more: Invite them to read the Bible with you.



Green - ready to follow Jesus: Meet regularly to disciple.



Blue - already following Jesus: Train to make disciples.

1. Connect

What is one high and one low from the past week?
OR What is one thing you are thankful for and one challenge you are facing?

2. Review

What do you remember from the previous passage?
How did you apply what you learned? Did you share it with anyone?

3. New Bible Passage

First, tell the story in your own words.

Then, read the passage from the Bible two times.

Discuss these questions:

- What stands out to you?
- What does it teach us about God?
- What does it teach us about people?

4. Practice

Practice retelling the Bible story in your own words.
Introduce new Discipleship Tool when appropriate.

5. Live it Out

What do you think you should do based on what you learned from this passage?

6. Pass it On

Is there anyone you could share this story with and tell them what you've learned?

Tools for Making Disciples

Teach Us to Pray

"This is how you should pray:

Our Father in heaven, may your name be honored.

May your kingdom come. May what you want to happen be done on earth as it is done in heaven.

Give us today our daily bread.

And forgive us our sins, just as we also have forgiven those who sin against us.

Keep us from sinning when we are tempted. Save us from the evil one.'

If you are unsure of how to spend time in prayer, you may find it helpful to pray through the prayer above as Jesus instructed His disciples. Pause after each line and pray it in your own words. Let's practice what that might look like together.

Which of these things could we improve or add? How?

"Instead, the law of the Lord gives them joy. They think about his law day and night." Psalm 1:2

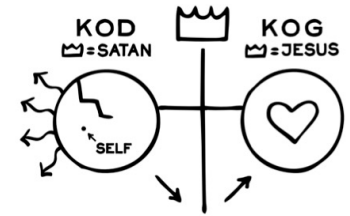
After reading a passage, ask these questions and write down your thoughts:

S: Lord, whom should I share this with?

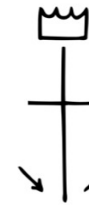
