Green - ready to follow Jesus: Meet regularly to disciple.



Blue - already following Jesus: Train to make disciples.

Part 1 - Connect Questions

- 1. What is one thing you are **thankful** for from the past week?
- 2. What is one **challenge** you are facing?

Part 2 - Discovery Questions

First, tell the story in your own words. Read the passage from the Bible two times. Ask the group to practice re-telling the passage.

- 3. What does this passage teach us about **God**?
- 4. What does this passage teach us about **people**?
- 5. What else **stands out** to you?

Part 3 - Go Questions

- 6. **Live it Out**: What do you think you should do based on what you learned from this passage?
- 7. **Pass it On**: Is there anyone you could share this story with and tell them what you've learned?

Tools for Making Disciples

Teach Us to Pray

"This is how you should pray:

Our Father in heaven, may your name be honored.

May your kingdom come. May what you want to happen be done on earth as it is done in heaven.

Give us today our daily bread.

And forgive us our sins, just as we also have forgiven those who sin against us.

Keep us from sinning when we are tempted. Save us from the evil one.'

Being the Church

What did these followers of Jesus do together? List everything you see in the passage.

Shared the gospel (41,47), baptized new believers (41), identified leaders (42,43), prayer (42), committed to Scripture (42), fellowship (42,44), giving (45), gathered regularly (46), communion (46), praise (47)

Which of these things is our group doing well?

Which of these things could we improve or add? How?

Read & Apply God's Word: The S.O.A.P. Method


"Instead, the law of the Lord gives them joy. They think about his law day and night." Psalm1:2

Scripture: Choose a passage and read it two times. Write down verses or phrases that stand out to you or that you want to remember.

Observation: Lord, what are you saying in this passage about yourself? About me?

Application: Lord, how should I obey this passage?

Pray & Pass it On: Talk with God about what you've read. Lastly, ask Him: Lord, whom should I share this with?
